Minutes of a meeting of Burneside Parish Council held at St Oswald's Church Room, Burneside, on Tuesday 5th April 2022 at 7pm.

*Present were Councillors William Huck (Chairman), Tonia Armer, Julie Huck, Judith Notley, Paul Senior, Keith Tondeur and Derrick Wade, District Councillor Pat Bell, two members of the public and Parish Clerk Kevin Price.*

#### Public participation:

- a. A resident expressed concerns and distress that items left on graves in St Oswald's Churchyard have been removed. The speaker said she had spoken to the Chancellor of the Diocese. The Chairman and Clerk both explained that the churchyard is entirely the responsibility of the Parochial Church Council (PCC) and the Parish Council has no authority whatsoever. Laws governing memorials on graves are laid down at Diocesan and national level.
- b. The resident's sentiments were echoed by the Residents Association and they will be supporting residents on this matter. *It was resolved that the Parish Council will contact the Incumbent to discuss the situation and the possibility of a meeting, following which the Council will report back to the resident concerned. Councillors Tondeur and Wade agreed to attend such a meeting.*
- c. A letter had been received suggesting, with reference to Agenda item 9d, that the Council might consider, rather than buying some silhouettes, sponsoring an ongoing all year round and lasting charitable trust in the name of Remembrance. An Educational Trust, bursary of events for the young were mentioned. The Clerk agreed to contact the writer to ask what exactly was being suggested. If necessary, this will be an agenda item for the next meeting.

**Council Vacancies:** There are still four vacancies on the Council and no firm expressions of interest have been received. There are three people who have shown an interest, one of whom was present at the meeting and it was agreed to keep them updated with the Council's work by including them on the mailing list for agendas and minutes.

**Reports:** Councillor Bell said there was not a lot she could say at this stage, being in purdah. Elections to the new 'shadow' Authority, Westmorland and Furness, will take place on 5th May and the new Authority will come into being in May 2023. Some of the boundaries of the Wards will be changed. She also reported that the planning department is still suffering delays.

**Updates:** *Councillor William Huck reported as follows, on the following matters:*

- a. An update was read out on behalf of the Biodiversity Group in regards to Bowston Weir removal, in particular the upstream habitats and the aim to protect this area as a community nature reserve.
- b. The overhanging planters at Steeles Row have been replanted.
- c. The planter for Bowston is ready to be installed at Winstanley Place; CCC would not allow it on the pavement.
- d. Chris Rabone has started grass cutting again for the season; areas will be managed for pollinators again.
- e. The old garage at Bowston has been removed.
- f. The Clerk has agreed to write again to the owners of the Bowston boat yard as no response had been received.
- g. The condition of the Burneside to Bowston footpath has been reported again.
- h. The Heart Start Training at the Bryce went well.
- i. The development of a bus shelter as proposed at a previous meeting: There is a need to give some time to this when available.
- j. The visit to the Mill by Councillors had been most interesting.
- k. Requesting the list of assets is on hold at present, pending the Local Government Reorganisation.
- l. The play park signs are ordered and installation is awaited.
- m. Potholes: Ratherheath Lane has been repaired but there are still further potholes to report and re-report.

#### UKRAINE

Just when we think things couldn't get any worse in Ukraine, they do! We are appalled at the atrocities we learn about in our newspapers and on our television screens and radios. We continue to pray for the people of Ukraine – and for peace. Maybe all of us have already contributed financially to various agencies and hopefully we will continue to do that. Sometimes, though, it can be hard to know to which agency to donate. You may be interested to hear of the emergency appeal launched by the Diocese in Europe and the USPG. Funds raised by the appeal will support Christian charities and churches carrying out humanitarian work both in Ukraine and responding to the arrival of refugees in neighbouring countries. Partners on the ground are providing food, medicine, shelter, care for children and people internally displaced in Ukraine. With refugees they are supplying care at the border and beyond, including attention to those from Africa and Asia as well as Ukrainians who are fleeing the war. #### ASCENSION DAY

When I was at school – more years ago than I care to remember – we always had a day off on Ascension Day so that we could all go to Church on this important Christian festival. Sadly today, although Ascension Day will still be celebrated, for many people it will pass by unnoticed. So what is it all about, and why is it important? The Bible tells us that after Jesus' resurrection on Easter Day he was present on earth for forty more days, appearing at various times to his disciples. On the fortieth day – a Thursday – Jesus met with his disciples on the top of a mountain, and it was from there, we read in the first chapter of Acts in the Bible, that he was taken up to heaven, returning to his Father. The disciples were told that one day Jesus will return. But what happens in the meantime? Sitting at God's right hand. We read that Jesus occupies a position of power and authority at the centre of the universe, 'exalted to the right hand of God' (Acts 2:33). This position was secured by His death and resurrection, enabling us to experience the life of heaven, including eternal life, forgiveness, healing and the power to transform lives and communities. Is this our expectation and experience?

Standing at God's right hand. Our experience of heaven is only partial because of the presence of suffering and disappointment in our lives. Stephen, the first Christian martyr, saw Jesus 'standing at the right hand of God' (Acts 7:56), when being stoned to death. Do we see that Jesus is on the throne and has a purpose for our lives, even when we are going through setbacks and difficulties?

As a result of Stephen's death, the church grew and the apostle Paul was impacted. Where do we see the fruit of the suffering in our lives? Praying at God's right hand. Finally, we are told that Jesus is 'interceding for us' at God's right hand (Romans 8:34 & Hebrews 7:25). Jesus is on our side at the heart of the universe and fully knows our needs when praying for us. He is for us, even when we feel defeated by the wrong things in our lives.

Because Jesus is in heaven, the Ascension opens up the possibility that we can experience the life of heaven, both now and in eternity.

This year Ascension Day falls on Thursday May 26th. Do join us for a Deanery service at Beetham Church at 7.30pm.

*Councillor Notley reported as follows:*

- a. CCC Highways had been contacted about the potholes at the foot of Garnett Bridge Road. The Hall Road ones are also in a bad state again. There is also a damaged kerb area at Holme Houses along the green.
- b. The allotments are now up and running, with a number of plots already taken. The lease has been signed and trees have been planted all around.
- c. The Community Fridge is very well used and has been given a hygiene inspection rating of 5. The cleaning rota for it needs to be formalised.
- d. Wildflower seeds have been applied for.
- e. There are a number of spare trees, and a use for these needs to be considered.

**Finance:** *It was resolved to pay the following accounts:*

K M Price	£177.00	Back pay for 2021-22 (following Pay Award)
K M Price	£177.84	Quarterly expenses to 31st March

- a. The Clerk gave a brief summary of the Council's balances as at 31st March 2022. The books will now be prepared for audit and the Interim Accounts will be presented for approval at the next meeting.
- b. An application for a grant towards to the parish Jubilee celebrations was considered and it was resolved to contribute £500. The group arranging the events will be invited to ask for a further grant later if this becomes necessary.
- c. It was resolved to purchase two Remembrance soldier figures at a cost of around £350.
- d. Proposals had been received from CCC Highways in respect of improvements at Bonningate (£1,039.80), and at Bowston (£500). A request will be made to check the Bonningate signage is to be on both sides of the road. One of the signs for Bowston will also be checked. The proposals for Burneside are ongoing and traffic monitoring tubes have recently been installed in the village. A new works agreement for the entry signs has been received and Councillors will check over the final designs.

**Queen's Jubilee events:** The Council is working closely with volunteers from the Cricket Club who are leading on this. Afternoon tea is planned for the Thursday, children's sports on the Friday and on Sunday there will be a Jubilee party held. Volunteers are required. A tree is to be planted in the autumn, commemorative mugs are on order for presentation to children and flag will be flown from the pole in St Oswald's churchyard. There will also be a Parish Jubilee Beacon on the Thursday evening.

A suggestion was made that the parish's planters could be planted in red, white and blue for the occasion.

**Burneside phone box:** Following a request from Burneside Residents Association, it was resolved, in principle, that the Council purchases the telephone kiosk in the village for future use as a book store/exchange. Councillor Tondeur will work with the Association in order to prepare the necessary application forms, etc.

**Planning:** *The following applications were considered:*

SL/2022/0231 4 Holme Houses, Burneside. Dropped kerb and removal of hedge to allow improved parking area. Approval recommended.

SL/2022/0255 Station Yard, Burneside. Siting of up to 36 self storage containers on the existing B8 storage site. Refusal recommended for the following reasons:

There will be increased traffic - on a private road, any noise will affect neighbours. The access road is not suitable. Light pollution is likely, there is no parking available and the proposal is out of character with the surrounding area. Drainage may also be an issue.

SL/2022/0270 Rockdene, Plantation Bridge. Alterations to existing dwelling with extensions to the east (rear) and south (side), conversion & raising roof height of detached garage to annexe living accommodation. Approval recommended.

**Open Forum:** It was reported that the celebrations for the 175th Anniversary of the Lakes Line had been well supported and successful.

- a. An invitation is extended to Councillors to attend a meeting of the Cropper Community Foundation to be held on 20th April.

**Agenda items for the next meeting:** Burneside Parish map - to consider re-printing.

- a. Trees and kerbs in Hollins Lane, and possible improvements to the turning point at the top of the lane. (Councillor Senior)


